## **A - ARTISTIC ACCOUTREMENTS**

### **A-1 - Ethan Lillemoe Wheel-Thrown and Hand-Carved Vase**

This award-winning and nationally-recognized artist has created a one-of-a-kind piece from clay. Lillemoe, from Fairburn, Georgia, was the winner (clay category) at the 2008 Atlanta Dogwood Arts Festival, one of the nation's largest and most diverse juried festivals in the country. He also won the 2007 Award of Excellence in Ceramics.
